When did this go LIVE?

This package, nicknamed "Development I", was released in the morning of Tuesday 18th February 2020.


What have we changed?

We've made a range of portal and back-office changes aimed at helping users and our authority partners alike. These include:

- **Submit button** we've made it clearer for first-time users on how to submit their application.
- Homepages we've improved the functionality and navigation on the homepage, and added a 'news' section at the top of the page. This is a work-in-progress so please bear with us.
- **Supplementary Information page** we've added better guidance and have introduced the ability for users to better sort and find documents that they've uploaded to their application.
- Maximum Application Size we've increased this from 100MB to 200MB for each application form.
- Linking Your Planning Form to a Previous Application the site now only allows users to link their ePlanning forms to one previous application. This was causing some issues in the system. If you want to link an Additional Documents form to more than one previous application, you can do so by copying the form and submitting it again.
- **Payment Options** are now displayed upfront on the Proposal Summary page when you start your application.
- Supporting Document for Appeals in addition to making an appeal to the DPEA using the service, you can now submit supporting documents relating to your using the Post Submission Additional Documents Form.
 Just check the box in the Main Details section of your form that this relates to an appeal, provide your case number, and we'll send it on to the DPEA.
